

## Open-Rank, Tenure-Track Professor of Liturgical Studies and Sacramental Theology School of Theology and Religious Studies

The School of Theology and Religious Studies at The Catholic University of America seeks to fill an open-rank, tenure-track position in Liturgical Studies and Sacramental Theology with a focus on Sacramental Theology to begin in the 2024-25 academic year.

We seek candidates who understand, are enthusiastic about, and will make a significant contribution to the <u>mission of the University</u>, which reads as follows: "As the national university of the Catholic Church in the United States, founded and sponsored by the bishops of the country with the approval of the Holy See, The Catholic University of America is committed to being a comprehensive Catholic and American institution of higher learning, faithful to the teachings of Jesus Christ as handed on by the Church. Applicants should have a doctorate with a specialization in Liturgical/Sacramental Theology and the ability to work with sources in their original languages. The successful candidate will be expected to teach in the undergraduate, graduate, and seminary programs, advise students, direct master and licentiate theses, doctoral dissertations, show evidence of the capacity to develop a strong original research agenda, and serve on committees of the school and University. Rank and salary will be determined on the basis of academic credentials and publication record.

- A one- to two-page personal statement indicating how your research, teaching, and service will make a distinctive contribution to our <u>University's mission</u> and to the vision of Catholic education outlined in the Apostolic Constitutions on Catholic Universities, <u>Ex Corde Ecclesiae</u>, and Ecclesiastical Faculties, <u>Veritatis Gaudium</u>
- (for priests or religious) a letter of endorsement by the applicant's ecclesiastical superior is required.

Review of applications will begin March 1 and continue until the position is filled.
