

Open-Rank, Tenure-Track Professor of New Testament School of Theology and Religious Studies

The School of Theology and Religious Studies at The Catholic University of America seeks to fill an open-rank, tenure-track position in New Testament to begin in the 2024-25 academic year.

We seek candidates who understand, are enthusiastic about, and will make a significant contribution to the <u>mission of the University</u>, which reads as follows: "As the national university of the Catholic Church in the United States, founded and sponsored by the bishops of the country with the approval of the Holy See, The Catholic University of America is committed to being a comprehensive Catholic and American institution of higher learning, faithful to the teachings of Jesus Christ as handed on by the Church. Area of specialization is open but scholars with interests and competencies in other areas of theology or religious studies are especially encouraged to apply. Responsibilities include teaching both undergraduate and graduate students; dissertation and thesis supervision; and service on committees. The successful candidate must possess a doctorate in New Testament prior to appointment and demonstrate competence in appropriate languages.

Applications should include the following:

- curriculum vitae
- A one- to two-page personal statement indicating how your research, teaching, and service will make a distinctive contribution to our <u>University's mission</u> and to the vision of Catholic education outlined in the Apostolic Constitutions on Catholic Universities, <u>Ex Corde Ecclesiae</u>, and Ecclesiastical Faculties, <u>Veritatis Gaudium</u>

Upon a favorable initial review, you will also be asked to offer:

- three letters of recommendation
- (for priests or religious) a letter of endorsement by the applicant's ecclesiastical superior is required.

Review of applications will begin March 1 and continue until the position is filled.
