Professor of Practice, Homiletics**

The School of Theology and Religious Studies at The Catholic University of America invites applications for a full-time, non-tenure track professor of practice faculty position in homiletics to begin Fall 2022. The successful applicant will possess a Ph.D., STD, or D. Min. with a specialization in homiletics or some related theological discipline and be a cleric in the Roman Catholic Church in good standing. Previous experience teaching homiletics and the ability to teach homiletics in Spanish is highly desirable.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach homiletics full-time, advise students, and serve on committees of the school and university. Directing theses, doctoral dissertations, and D.Min project treatises will be expected contingent upon the applicant's terminal degree. Rank and salary will be determined on the basis of academic credentials and publication record.
