- three confidential letters of recommendation, submitted separately by recommenders to philosophy@cua.edu, and
- transcripts of all graduate work.
- A one- to two-page personal statement indicating how your research, teaching, and service
 will make a distinctive contribution to our <u>University's mission</u> and to the vision of Catholic
 education outlined in the Apostolic Constitution on Catholic Universities <u>Ex Corde Ecclesiae</u>.
 Reference to the <u>Veritatis Gaudium</u> in one's personal statement is also welcomed.
