The Busch School of Business at The Catholic University of America seeks candidates to fill a full-time, tenure-track or tenured faculty position to begin in August 2026.

The Catholic University of America is the national university of the Catholic Church with 6,000 undergraduate and graduate students in more than 180 academic programs on a residential campus in the heart of the nation's capital. The Tim and Steph Busch School of Business, founded in 2013, is committed to the application of Catholic Social Doctrine to business through thought leadership and the formation of students as virtuous Catholic business leaders. The Busch School is housed in Maloney Hall, a beautiful century-old collegiate gothic building that reopened in early 2019 after a \$37 million renovation.

We seek candidates who understand, are enthusiastic about, and will make a significant contribution to the mission of the University, which reads as follows:

The position is a tenure-track or tenured appointment. All ranks will be considered. Candidates at senior faculty ranks may be considered for the Busch School's Centesimus Annus Joseph M. Della Ratta Family Chair in Business and Economics. Responsibilities include academic research, teaching at the undergraduate and graduate level, mentoring students, and service to the department, school, and University.

Candidates should have a passion for the <u>School's mission</u>, a relevant and rigorous research agenda, and a strong commitment to excellence in teaching. Applicants must have a doctoral degree in business or a related field.

For full consideration, applications are due by **Friday**, **January 16**, **2026**. The application should include:

- a letter of interest clearly articulating your areas of teaching and research expertise,
- a curriculum vitae,
- a list of three references, and
- a personal mission statement indicating how your teaching, service, and prior experience will make a distinctive contribution to the life of our school, to our University's mission, and to the vision of Catholic education outlined in the <u>Apostolic</u> <u>Constitution on Catholic Universities</u>, <u>Ex Corde Ecclesiae</u>.
