  - Then faculty and senate (probably Jan 2020)
  - Approval by BOT in March 2020 needed

# Dean Searches

- Three dean searches are underway:
  - Architecture
  - Arts & Sciences
  - NCSSS
- The Search Committees for all have been finalized
- Russell Reynolds has been engaged as a partner for these three searches
- RR was on campus for two days this week meeting with the search committees and the faculties
- Library
  - I've been meeting with faculty about the University Library
  - The consistent message has been that we need to invest more in the Library
  - I think the message is pretty clear and is 100% consistent with our shared goal of academic excellence as a research university
  - I will be looking for ways to do so
  - And will be directly consulting with faculty and engaging them in the process
- Midterm Grades
  - Lynn has been meeting with Student Government Senators and there is a desire to implement the reporting of midterm grades for all students, not just freshmen
  - We will be pilot testing this in the Spring Semester
